REGISTRATION FOR THE 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR

Currently enrolled students and families with **kindergarten ONLY** may register at their home school on:

May 14th and 15th (5-8:00pm), 2008 and June 10, 2008 from 10am-2pm.

Currently enrolled students and new students may register at Delores Moye Elementary School on: July 29, 2008 (1-7:30 pm)

TWO (2) proofs of residency in O'Fallon District No. 90 must be provided at this registration. Please see reverse side for all details

FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS

Free/reduced lunch applications will be available at the July registration or in the school office after July 29.packets. If you feel you qualify, please complete and return. The principals will review the application and you will be notified later if you qualify. This form will cover both breakfast and lunch.

SCHOOL LUNCHES & BREAKFAST COST

School lunch prices for the 2008-2009 school year will be **\$2.00** and **\$1.10** for breakfast.

Accounts will be set up for each student and money may be deposited to this account at any time. Each student will then be given a four-digit access code to use when paying for lunch or breakfast. ***Checks should be made payable to your school.***

STUDENT INSURANCE

For the 2008-2009 school year, information on supplemental insurance will be sent home in August or September. This is an optional insurance that you may purchase for your student. No information will be available at registration.

STUDENT PHYSICALS

The State of Illinois requires that all students in KINDERGARTEN and SIXTH GRADE and all STUDENTS NEW TO AN ILLINOIS SCHOOL must have a physical done within one year of entry. *An exception has been made for the sixth grade physical for the 2008-2009 school year. Talk with your building nurse.* The physical must be on a State of Illinois form or one that meets the Illinois requirements and must be signed by an MD or DO, a physician assistant or advance practice nurse. In addition, all immunizations must be up to date with the requirements of the State of Illinois. Those requirements are attached to the physical exam form. Any student not in compliance by the third Friday in September will be excluded from school. For assistance with physical examinations and immunizations, contact the St. Clair County Health Department (233-6170) or Southern Illinois Health Care Foundation (337-8905). A Dental examination is required for grades K, 2 & 6.

SPORTS PHYSICALS

A new physical is required **before trying out** for any sport and must be dated after June 1. There will be **NO** sports physical evening held at the Junior High this summer.

Before and After School Care

Childcare is available to District 90 students in grades K-6. Students must be registered and fees paid for either 1-3 days per week or 4-5 days per week. The morning program begins at 7:00 am and the after school program ends at 6:00 pm. An informational brochure is available thru your school.

TRANSPORTATION

PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

Preschool is available for District 90 students between the ages of 3-5. The **Preschool Plus** is a full day tuition program between the hours of 7:00-5:00. The **Early Achiever's Academy** is a half-day tuition preschool program with a morning or afternoon class. Two, three, or five-day options are available for both programs. Tuition is a monthly payment and dependent upon which program option you choose. All classes are held at Marie Schaefer School.
