

2008-2009 Immunizations - Doses and Intervals

Entering Kindergarten through Grade 12:

Polio: 3 or more doses with last dose administered (adm) on or after 4th birthday, at intervals of no less than 6 wks, last dose at least 6 months since previous dose.

***DTP:** 4 or more doses with last dose adm on or after 4th birthday, at intervals of no less than 4 wks, last dose at least 6 months since previous dose.

Measles: 2 doses, 1st dose adm 12 mo or older, 2nd dose no less than 1 mo after 1st.

Rubella: 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

Mumps: 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

** **Hepatitis B** [not required for k-4 or 12]
3 dose series req, interval between 1st and 2nd dose, at least 4 wks, between 2nd and 3rd, at least 2 months.
Required at grades 5, 6, 7, 8, 9,10,11.

HIB [not required for k-12]
Not recommended for children 59 months of age or older

Varicella: (chickenpox) required for any child 2 yrs. or older entering a program under the kindergarten level to include preschool and day care. Also required for children entering kindergarten through 6th grade.
1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

Entering a program below the Kindergarten level:

Polio: 3 or more doses adm no less than 6 weeks apart

DTP: 4 or more doses, adm no less than 4 weeks apart, last dose interval at least 6 months

Measles: 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

Rubella: 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

Mumps: 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

Hepatitis B: 3 doses, interval between 1st and 2nd dose, at least 4 wks, between 2nd and 3rd, at least 2 months

HIB: series in infancy or 2 doses between 15-59 months of age.

Varicella: (chickenpox) 1 dose, adm 12 mo or older

* **DTP,** if 10 years have elapsed, additional Td required. Six year olds may receive TD in lieu of DTP. Pertussis not recommended for children 7 and older. For children entering school other than Pre-K, K, and 1st grade, 3 doses of DTP/DtaP/Td, with intervals no less than 4 weeks apart.

** **Hepatitis B:** All students in pre kindergarten, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades are required to have proof of vaccination for the 2007-2008 school year.
